

COVID-19 Contingency Plan

After the communication of the Prime Minister and following the disclosure of The Council of Ministers Resolution No. 33- A/2020 of April 30, 2020 we will partially open our space. In a first phase we will open most of our outdoor activities, in accordance with the Contingency Plan for Coronavirus Disease (COVID19) established by the company.

We will open the following outdoor activities on May 24, 2020:

- The four Paintball and Lasertag fields with 2000 m2 each;
- The 800m2 synthetic turf field for the Practice Bazooka Ball or Archery or Bubble Football;
- Crazy Carts asphalt tracks of 800m2;

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1. INTRODUCTION

This document provides the essential points of the Contingency Plan of RAD- Sports Activities, Lda for Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) established by RAD- Atividades Desportivos, Lda,. It provides information to the company's employees about this new disease, on the measures to prevent and control this infection, and on the procedures and measures to be adopted in the face of the identification of suspected and/or confirmed cases.

The Contingency Plan of RAD- Sports Activities, Lda for Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) was developed based on the guidelines of the Directorate-General for Health (DGS) and the best scientific evidence available to date. Employees of RAD- Atividades Desportivos, Lda will be informed about coronavirus disease (COVID19) and on ways to avoid transmission, through the most appropriate means: Newsletter, by email, displaying posters in common spaces, etc. Similarly, information on the recommendations and procedures established in the Contingency Plan of RAD- Sports Activities, Lda for Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) will be widely disseminated, through the most appropriate means.

Rad- Sports Activities, Lda is committed to the protection of the health and safety of its employees, also having an important role to play in limiting the negative impact of this outbreak on the community, given the valences of knowledge they hold in various areas.

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2- WHAT IS A SUSPICIOUS CASE The classification of a case as suspected of coronavirus disease (COVID-19) must comply with clinical and epidemiological criteria. The following definition is based on the information currently available in the European Centre for Contingency Plan COVID 19 - RAD- Sports Activities, Lda - May 2020

3 -DEFINITION OF THE ISOLATION AREA An area of isolation is established in rad- Sports Activities, Lda. The placement of a employee or visitor suspected of COVID-19 infection in an isolation area aims to prevent other employees from being exposed and infected. The main objective of this measure is to prevent the spread of a communicable disease. This area is equipped with:

1. chair (for rest and comfort of the employee suspected of COVID-19 infection, pending case validation and possible transport by INEM);
2. Kit with water and some non-perishable food;
3. waste container (with non-manual opening and plastic bag);
4. antiseptic solution of alcoholic base;
5. Paper towels;
6. surgical mask(s);
7. Disposable gloves;
8. Thermometer.

In this area, there is a properly equipped sanitary facility, namely with soap dispenser and paper towels, for the exclusive use of the suspect case. Employees should be informed of the location of the isolation area in their institution. Contingency Plan COVID 19 - RAD- Sports Activities, Lda - May 2020

4-DESIGNATION OF FOCAL POINT Rad- Sports Activities, Lda will appoint a Responsible for the management of any suspected case of COVID-19. Employees will be informed of who is responsible. It is to this Focal Point that should be reported a situation of framed disease of a collaborator or visitor with symptoms and epidemiological link compatible with the definition of possible case of COVID-19. Whenever a situation of an employee or visitor with symptoms is reported, the Focal Point should ensure compliance with the procedures established in the Contingency Plan of RAD- Sports Activities, Lda for Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19). The Focal Point will be the element that will accompany the suspicious case to the designated isolation area, provide the necessary support and trigger the contacts established in the Contingency Plan of *Company Name*. 5- PROCEDURES In a SUSPICIOUS CASE

In a validated suspicious situation:

- a) The employee or sick visitor must remain in the isolation area (with surgical mask, provided that his/her clinical condition permits), until the arrival of the team of the National Institute of Medical Emergency (INEM) , activated by DGS, which ensures transport to the reference hospital, where biological samples will be taken for laboratory tests at INSA;
- b) The access of other employees or visitors to the isolation area is prohibited (except to the focal point);
- c) The validated suspect case shall remain in the isolation area until the arrival of the INEM team activated by the DGS, in order to restrict, to the minimum necessary, the contact of this case with other employees or visitors. Additional movements of the suspect case on the premises should be avoided. Dgs informs the Regional Health Authority of laboratory results, which in turn informs the Local Health Authority. The Local Health Authority shall inform the direction of the organic unit of the laboratory test results and:

d) If the case is not confirmed, it shall be closed to COVID-19, and the usual procedures of the organic unit are applied, including cleaning and disinfection of the isolation area.

e) If confirmed, the isolation area shall be closed until the decontamination (cleaning and disinfection) is validated by the Local Health Authority. This ban can only be lifted by the Local Health Authority. Contingency Plan COVID 19 - RAD- Sports Activities, Lda - May 2020

6- PROCEDURES in a CONFIRMED CASE In the confirmed case situation, the Responsible Person must:

a) Provide cleaning and disinfection (decontamination) of the isolated area;

b) strengthen cleaning and disinfection, especially on surfaces often handled and most used by the confirmed patient, most likely to be contaminated. Pay particular attention to cleaning and disinfection of the meeting room, desks, including materials and equipment used by the confirmed case;

c) Store the waste of the confirmed case Contingency Plan COVID 19 - RAD- Sports Activities, Lda – May 2020

7- PREVENTION MEASURES

Rad- Sports Activities, Lda will adopt the following measures:

a) Alert the Worker with symptoms and epidemiological link (compatible with the definition of suspected case of COVID-19), proceeding quickly to the internal communication between the Worker with symptoms - or the worker who identifies a worker with symptoms in the company - and the direct management and the employer (or someone designated by the company).

b) Train and sensitize workers to: Basic hand hygiene procedures (e.g. washing hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds; if they are not available use a hand sanitizer that has at least 70% alcohol, covering all the surfaces of the hands and rubbing them until they are dry; soap and water should preferably be used if the hands are visibly dirty). Anti-skeptical solution is made available to all workers in individual dosing device. Respiratory label procedures (e.g. avoid coughing or sneezing on your hands; coughing or sneezing to the forearm or sleeve, with the forearm flekey or wearing a tissue; sanitizing your hands after contact with respiratory secretions); Surgical mask placement procedures (including hand hygiene before placing and after removing the mask); Social conduct procedures (e.g. changing the frequency and/or form of contact between workers and between them and customers - avoiding handshake, shared jobs). 8- CONDITIONS FOR USE OF OUR SPACE Activities in operation in the first phase:

- The four paintball and lasertag fields with 2000 m2 each;
- The 800m2 synthetic turf field for the Bazooka Ball, Archery and Bubble Football practice;
- Crazy Carts asphalt track of 800m2 Rad- Sports Activities, Lda will implement the following measures for opening outdoor activities: All activities require prior booking in our reservation center 917344437 or by our email ricbowling@netcabo.pt. All members who will use the space must be identified. Participants can only be in our space if the group is adults. If the group consists only of minors, parents may be present, but have to stay in the delimited and

The conditions for the frequency of our external activities are:

8.1. SPACE MANAGEMENT Meeting Point a) Paintball / Lasertag The meeting point is in the parking lot of the Paintball and Lasertag fields at Gil Eanes Street, Murches 2755-229 Alcabideche.

b) BazookaBall, Archery, Bubble Football and Crazy Carts The meeting point is on our synthetic turf football field that sits at the back of Playbowling - skirting the playbowling cascais building outside (we have signs).

Payment Methods • Payment can be made by bank transfer (prior) and the invoice sent by email or delivered on the day, but without the customer entering the interior space (Playbowling). Contingency Plan COVID 19 - RAD- Sports Activities, Lda - May 2020

RULES FOR THE CLIENT

- Entry will be allowed only to users who have previously booked the service.
 - Users must respect the booking times (start and end times).
 - Access to the interior is only allowed to go to the bathrooms.
 - No use of our changing rooms.
 - In each field, there will be a maximum of 10 people, 5 people for each team that in fields of 2000m² corresponds to possible distances of 200m² per person.
 - In the Carts there will be only 2 people in the 800m² and in the synthetic grass field a maximum of 10 people in the 800m².
 - The material to be delivered to carry out the activity will be previously disinfected by the Bowling staff and, as an additional measure, each user will perform a second cleaning before starting the service and cleaning after the end of the activity.
 - We advise that each user comes with their own water bottle and must use a mask.
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- We will have for sale protective masks in case any used need mask.
 - Users must respect the signs, in particular the delimitation of spaces.
 - Users undertake to comply with all procedures and guidance of any member of our staff related to the prevention of contagion by the SARS-Cov-2 virus.
 - There will be 1 hour interval between bookings.

DISTANCING

- The movement in the spaces must respect the minimum distance of 2 meters.
- During the activity users must observe the markings (4 m²). Contingency Plan COVID 19 - RAD- Sports Activities, Lda - May 2020

HYGIENE MEASURES -CUSTOMER AND EMPLOYEES

- All users must respect the respiratory label.
- Customer and staff temperature control.
- We will have a disinfectant dispenser in each field for hands. All users must disinfect their hands frequently and always before and after the activity, mandatorily.
- It is recommended that the user provide, in addition, his personal protective material with which he/she must be accompanied (mask, alcoholic vaporizer, alcoholic gel or disinfectant wasathes).
- Next to each area of activity we will always have an area where the disinfected materials will be delivered by a staff member.
- After use, users must place the material in the area of dirty material that will be identified.
- Between activities the material and equipment as well as all surfaces where users and staff play will be disinfected by our staff.
- Staff will wear visor and protective mask. Contingency Plan COVID 19 - RAD- Sports Activities, Lda - May 2020
- Users should only use/touch their material (numbered and non-transferable material), not sharing any material / equipment.
- In these activities there are no player substitutions, it is not part of the rules of the game. We count on the collaboration of all so that everything goes well and in the hope that we can open more areas and activities from the month of June. The opening of the remaining areas will depend on how the situation in Portugal evolves, which we count on being soon,.
